Each year, over 10,000 books are distributed to children through the Book Nook.

We are currently looking for a volunteer to join our team in the Book Nook program at our head office at **2010 Eglinton Ave. West, Suite 400, Toronto, ON, M6E 2K3**. This volunteer position is needed **once a month**, generally it is the 2nd Thursday of every month but the day can vary. The shift will begin at **1pm**, for a minimum of 2 hours, with the option to stay until 4pm.

The volunteer needs to have the following skills:

- Able to work independently
- Able to work in a group
- Able to lift boxes of books
- Some knowledge and interest in children's books!

The job duties are:

- Assisting the Book Nook Coordinator in counting the books and documenting the total sum of books per delivery
- Assisting the Book Nook Coordinator in moving books to an assigned space to be processed
- Sorting and cleaning gently-used children's books
- Stickering gently-used children's books
- Organizing book room and book storage area
- Cleaning shelves and displaying children's books
