Our program intervenes at a critical time in children's lives. Many of the children in our program are experiencing behavioural challenges and special needs due to external stressors in their lives. Our program builds confidence, teaches empathy and equips these children and their families with the knowledge and skills needed to overcome these stressors and succeed in school and in life. The Homework Club stands as a positive, nurturing environment in communities where it is all too easy for children to learn bullying and discouragement.
