“Play & Learn” and “Family Night”

Ages: newborn – 6 years

Play and Learn is a program where parents, caregivers and their children meet others and play interactively in a learning environment. The program includes creative activities, music, pre-reading, math concepts, large and fine motor activities.

“Baby and Me” (Ages: newborn - 12 months) and “Baby Time” (Ages: newborn - 18 months)

Parents/Caregivers and their baby can meet with other parents in a relaxing, social environment. There is a variety of stimulating activities, informative conversations, interactive games, songs and finger plays.

Toddler Time - Ages 13 months - 30 months

Parents/Caregivers and their toddlers interact through stationary play-based activities to support social, sensory and physical skills.

New Programs Description

LIVING AND LEARNING WITH BABY

Free program for parents/caregivers and babies 6 weeks to 6 months. During this program a TPN talks about topics such as adjusting to parenthood, infant nutrition, safety, growth and development and much more.

GRANDPARENTS PROGRAM

This is a free program for grandparents and their children (0-6). They get the opportunity to connect with other grandparents while participating in early learning activities with their grandchildren.

TODDLER TIME

Free drop in program for parents and caregivers with children 12 months to 30 months to interact and learn through play.
