

Programs offered at our EarlyON Child and Family Centres

“Play & Learn” and “Family Night”

Ages: newborn – 6 years

This program lets parents, caregivers, and their children meet others and play interactively in a learning environment. It includes creative activities, drama, music, pre-reading, and math concepts along with gross and fine motor activities.

“Baby & Me” *Ages: newborn – 12 months*

“Baby Time” *Ages: newborn – 18 months*

Parents, caregivers and their baby can meet other parents in a relaxing, social environment. There is a variety of stimulating activities, informative conversations, interactive games, songs and finger plays.

“Toddler Time”

Ages: 13 months – 30 months

Parents, caregivers and their toddlers interact through stationary play-based activities to support social, sensory and physical skills.

“Esso Math”

A program for children 3 – 6 years and their parents/caregivers designed to help children understand math concepts, develop logical thinking, and enjoy numbers in familiar ways

“Parent Support Group”

A collaborative program to support families of children with special needs and concurrent program for their children to address social, communication and independence skills

Living and Learning with Baby

LLB focuses on parents of newborn babies. This parenting program is co-facilitate with Toronto Public Health

Grandparents Program

This is a free program for grandparents and their children 0-6. They get the opportunity to connect with other grandparents while participating in early learning activities with their grandchildren.
