Directions: Poke a skewer through the center of a paper plate. Use a ruler to draw a straight line across the center of the paper plate. Draw several more lines to form a pie pattern and paint or colour your pie pieces in with different colours. Cut out two small circle from the foam	as possible, the popsicle sticks will help to stabilize the levels. Then set your toy character(s) on top. How strong is your structure? Does the toy fall off or balance on one level?	<u>Directions:</u> Start by laying your paper on a cookie sheet-this will help keep the salt from getting too messy. Draw out your design with glue. Sprinkle salt over the glue before it dries. Now lightly paint on to the salt. Let it dry	Take a roll of paper towel and cut in half. Place one half of the roll of paper towels in an airtight container. Pour all ingredients over the ½ roll of paper towels and place the lid on the container. Then flip the container over until the paper towels are fully saturated. Once they are fully saturated, you can easily	grease a mini muffin pan. Mix all ingredients together. Add in the mix-ins of your choice; stir to combine. Spoon the mixture into your muffin pan. Bake for 15-18 minutes. Enjoy!
