<p>Paper Plate Spinning Wheels</p> <p><u>Materials:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paper Plate • Wooden Skewer • Tempura paint, Markers or Crayons • Foam Sheet • Glue • Ruler <p><u>Directions:</u> Poke a skewer through the center of a paper plate. Use a ruler to draw a straight line across the center of the paper plate. Draw several more lines to form a pie pattern and paint or colour your pie pieces in with different colours. Cut out two small circle from the foam sheet. Glue the foam circles to the top and bottom of the paper plate around the skewer. Let it dry and spin your wheel!</p> 	<p>Engineering Challenge</p> <p><u>Materials:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15-20 cups • 20 large popsicle sticks • Plastic toy character(s) for the tower <p><u>Directions:</u> Using the materials, build a structure as tall as possible, the popsicle sticks will help to stabilize the levels. Then set your toy character(s) on top. How strong is your structure? Does the toy fall off or balance on one level?</p> 	<p>Firework Salt Paintings</p> <p><u>Materials:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Table salt • Paper (black really makes the colours pop) • Watercolours or food colouring • Paint brushes • White glue • Cookie sheet <p><u>Directions:</u> Start by laying your paper on a cookie sheet- this will help keep the salt from getting too messy. Draw out your design with glue. Sprinkle salt over the glue before it dries. Now lightly paint on to the salt. Let it dry and hang your picture up in your house!</p> 	<p>Homemade Disinfectant Wipes</p> <p><u>Materials:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Roll of paper towel • Airtight container • 1 ½ cups warm water • 2 tablespoons white vinegar • 1 ½ tablespoons Dawn dish soap <p><u>Directions:</u> Take a roll of paper towel and cut in half. Place one half of the roll of paper towels in an airtight container. Pour all ingredients over the ½ roll of paper towels and place the lid on the container. Then flip the container over until the paper towels are fully saturated. Once they are fully saturated, you can easily remove the cardboard tube from the center of the paper towels. Viola, you have your own disinfectant wipes!</p> 	<p>Mini Banana Oat Muffins</p> <p><u>Materials:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 cup oats • 1 teaspoon vanilla • 4 large bananas (smashed) • Mix-ins of your choice (optional) <p><u>Directions:</u> Preheat your oven to 350° and generously grease a mini muffin pan. Mix all ingredients together. Add in the mix-ins of your choice; stir to combine. Spoon the mixture into your muffin pan. Bake for 15-18 minutes. Enjoy!</p>
