IN-PERSON PARENT-CHILD PROGRAMS - OUTDOOR / INDOOR

Please read the following important notes prior to registering for an in-person (outdoor or indoor) program:

Please be advised:

- **One Adult Per Family:** We ask that only ONE adult per family attend our in-person programs. Please register the adult and child (ren) that will be participating during all weeks of the program. **Only those who are pre-registered for the program will be able to participate. No walk-ins or non-registered participants allowed.**
- **Health/Safety Guidelines:** All adults and children will be required to wear a face mask at all times. (It is recommended that children 2 to 5 years old wear a mask). Additional health and safety information will be sent by email including daily COVID-19 screening.
Families cannot sign up for a program if anyone in their home currently has symptoms or a confirmed case of COVID-19. If you discover that you have developed symptoms or have a confirmed case of COVID-19 at any time after registering, please email the staff to cancel your spot and do not attend the program.
Upon arrival to the program, families will be required to undergo a COVID-19 screening. If a family is determined to be ineligible to attend the program, they will be asked to leave.
Families need to maintain a physical distance from staff and other families of a minimum of 2 metres.
- **Eventbrite Instructions:** When registering on Eventbrite, please select the number of tickets required for your family (one ticket for each child participant and only ONE ticket for an adult).
