- Accommodation requests taken during registration process.
- Language translation and ASL available.

VACCINE

- Ages 5-29 will be provided with Pfizer
- Ages 30+ will be provided with Moderna

ELIGIBILITY

For 1st Doses:

- Anyone 5+ years of age on day of vaccination

For 2nd doses:

- Ages 5 to 11 must be 8+ weeks after first dose
- Ages 12 and up must be 21+ days after Pfizer first dose / 28+ days after Moderna first dose / 8+ weeks after AstraZeneca first dose

For 3rd Doses:

- Ages 18+
- Must be 3+ months (84 days) after second dose

No health card needed.

Please bring proof of age (passport, birth certificate, etc.)
